


Left: Several players have won international honours whilst at Field Mill. John McClelland was the first to win a full cap as a Mansfield Town player, for Northern Ireland in 1981.

Below: Paul Holland was selected as an England Under-21 player for the Toulon tournament in the summer of 1995, and he played in the same side as David Beckham against Brazil.





Above: Darren Ward's performances during the 1994/95 season earned him a call-up to the Wales Under-21 squad. However he left Field Mill in the summer of 1995 before playing, though he did later in his career play for both the full Wales side and the Under-21 side.

Right: Colin Calderwood formed a brilliant partnership with George Foster at the centre of the Stags' defence which only conceded a club record 38 goals in 1984/85. He left for Swindon Town in the summer of 1985. The sell-on clause for this deal later earned the Stags £655,000 which is a club record. He played for Scotland in the 1998 World Cup.
